Model stitched on 18 count White Aida by Stitchery Barn or the fabric of your choice.

Stitch Count: 56 x 56. Stitched 2 over 1.

Stitched area measures 3.1 x 3.1 in - 7.9 x 7.9 cm.

Pattern is stitched with DMC Embroidery Floss or Stitchery Barn Embroidery Floss.

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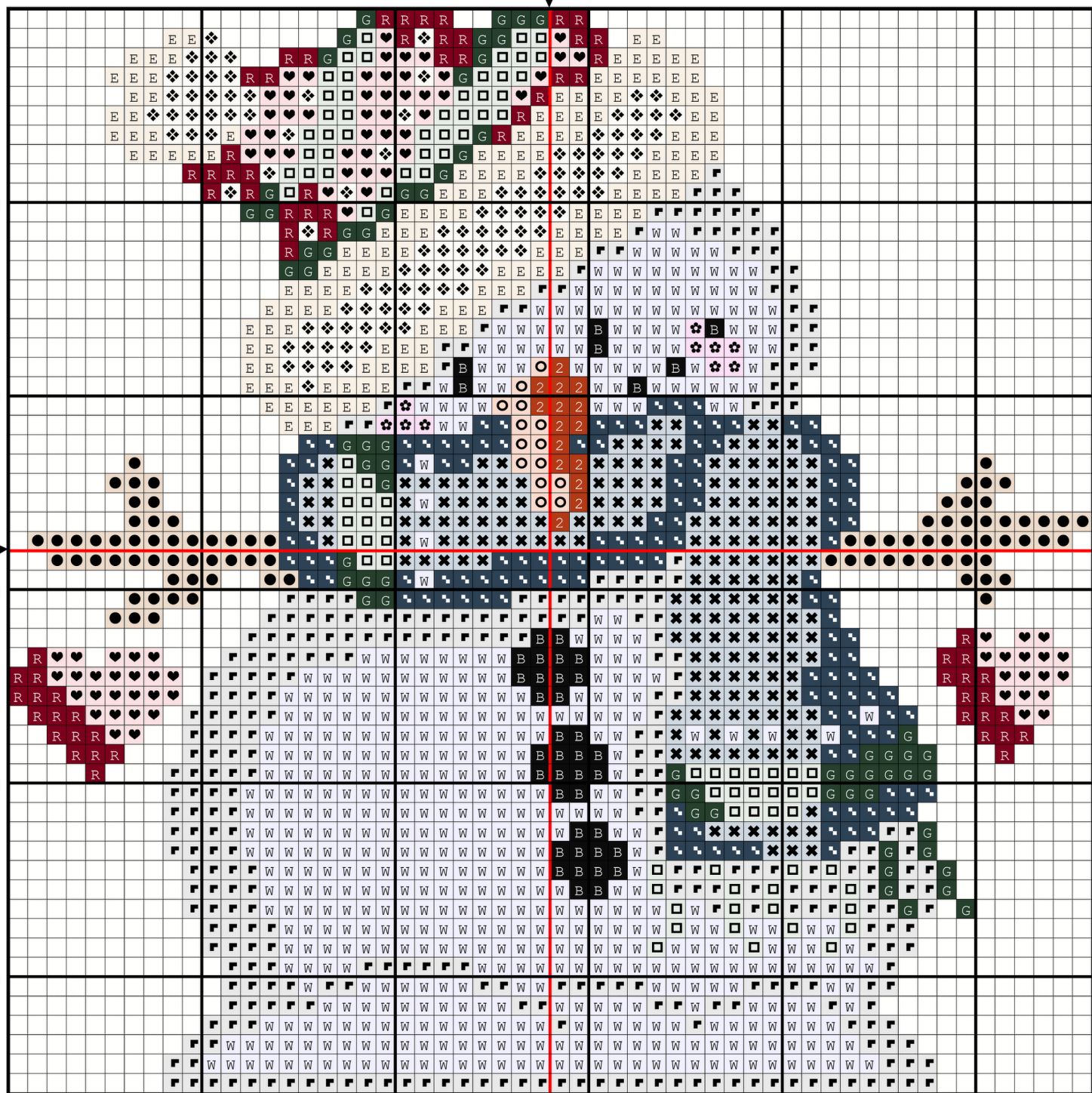

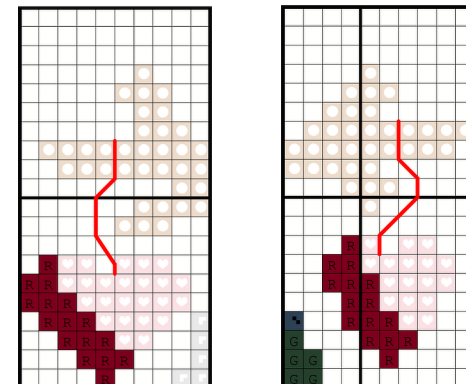
Counted Cross Stitch Pattern

Main Chart

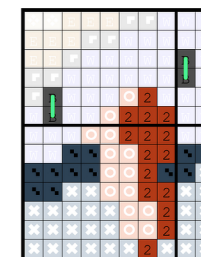

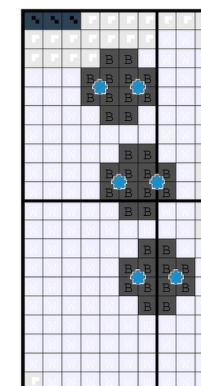
Charts for Backstitch



Using the colour 310 or Black Bird,
the ornament strings shown in red
are backstitched with 2 strands of thread.



Using the colour B5200 or Swan,
the snowman's eyes shown in green
are backstitched with 2 strands of thread.



Using the colour B5200 or Swan,
2 strands of thread are used
to create the French knots shown in blue.
